



Call Before You Dig

Save yourself money and time: call 811 before you dig.

Why?

If you dig without calling and damage a utility line, you will be responsible for the damage.

The fee for a damaged telephone line averages \$150-350.

In America, approximately 38% of Utility Damage is due to someone not making the call.

When to Call:



**Know what's below.
Call before you dig.**

- At least 48 hours prior to digging, not including weekends or holidays.
- ANYTIME you are going to dig—whether it's for industrial/construction work or for a project around your own home.
- ANY depth of digging. Grading work and road work can raise or drop utilities, so the depth of utility lines is only guaranteed until midnight on the day of installation.



Even if you think you know where the utility line is, it may have shifted in depth; **play it safe and call ahead!**
